Adeline Martha Johnson, age 102, of Wibaux, Montana passed away on Sunday, January 12, 2014 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. In 1954 William passed away and shortly after Adeline became a realtor and worked in Billings until her retirement. In September of 2008, Adeline moved to Wibaux and lived with her sister Emajeane for a couple of months. Christmas of 2008 she moved to the Golden Valley Manor in Beach and was able to spend her 98th, 99th, and 100th birthdays at the Manor. Adeline then moved to the Wibaux County Nursing Home shortly after her 100th birthday in January of 2011 and was able to

spend her next two birthdays in Wibaux. Her 103rd birthday would have been celebrated on January 15, 2014. Adeline lived a very interesting life and traveled the world to places including; China, Poland, Jerusalem, Ireland, Israel, Spain and numerous other places. She was a member of the Catholic Daughters, a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Billings and a member of St. Patrick's Altar Society. She was very a proud voter and was proud to say that she had voted in every election since the time she was able to. She always enjoyed life to the fullest. Adeline enjoyed running the hotel and helped many people who were in need of help. She was always one to help the down and out and get them on their feet. She never forgot her God and was faithful to him and his precepts. Her Bible was well read and she always prayed for forgiveness. Adeline was preceded in death by her loving husband, William; three brothers, Clifford, Dayton and Irving Jendro; five brothers-in-law, Wilbur Chaffee, Alf Helvick, Willis Stull, Herman Feldmann and Neil Kennedy and numerous nieces and nephews.
