November 22, 1916 - December 27, 2004

Adellas Marie Johnson, age 88, of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota, died December 19, 2004 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson, North Dakota. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 A.M.
