Agnes Marcella Kinney, age 75, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Thursday, February 21, 2019 at the Glendive Medical Center. Memorial services will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Saturday, April 6, 2019 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Reverend Avis Anderson officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Agnes was born on July 2, 1943 in Glendive, a daughter of Horace "Red" and Hazel (Kennedy) Kinney. She was raised and educated in Glendive and graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1961. Agnes was a secretary for one of the local credit unions for several years before beginning her career with the county. She started in the Superintendent's office before later moving to the Treasurer's office until her retirement in 2008. During her retirement she enjoyed quiet time at the ranch and helping with the cows. She also spent a lot of time traveling, taking cruises, playing cards, and bowling.

Throughout the years Agnes was active in the community and was a member of several committees, including: Secretary of the Fair Board for many years, an original member of the G.A.T.E. committee, a member of the Women of the Moose, and she was also a member of the Cowbells.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Horace and Hazel; one sister, Frances Kinney; and one brother-in-law, Bruce Haley.

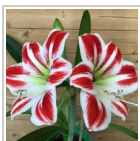
