



## Agnes Marie Miesaloski

August 11, 1930 - October 1, 2024

Agnes Marie Miesaloski, age 94, of Wibaux, Montana passed away on Tuesday, October 1, 2024 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 PM on Thursday, October 24, 2024 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM on Friday, October 25, 2024 at St. Peter's Catholic Church with Father Jijo officiating. Rite of Committal will be in the Wibaux County Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Agnes was born August 11, 1930, to Dominik and Katherine (Schaan) Job at their family home in Wibaux County. At the age of ten, Agnes and her fourteen siblings lost their mother and their dad moved them to town.

On October 18, 1951, she married the love of her life, Richard Miesaloski. They lived on the Miesaloski family farm where they raised their five kids: Frank, John, Bev, Mary, and Lori. She was a hard worker and a devoted wife who helped Richard with all the daily chores, plus worked outside the home. Agnes was a wonderful cook and baker.

Due to Richard's failing health, they sold the farm and moved to town where Agnes managed the liquor store for almost twenty years and was Richard's devoted caretaker. When he entered the nursing home in Glendive, MT she sold her home in Wibaux and moved to be closer to him and continued to be his caretaker even when he was in the nursing home. After he passed away, she spent time with her daughter, Lori in Seattle, WA, and Bev in Missoula,

MT.

In 2006, she moved to Grandview Retirement Home in Glendive, where she lived for twelve years, then she moved to the Golden Valley Manor in Beach, ND until June of 2022, when her health was failing. Agnes then moved to the Wibaux County Nursing Home until the time of her passing.

Agnes was the best wife, mother, sister, grandma, and friend who will be sorely missed. And above all, her faith was the most important part of her life.
