Aimee attended the Olson School throughout the eighth grade, Carlyle High School for 3 ½ years and graduated from Wibaux High School in Wibaux, Montana with the class of 1944. She met the love of her life, Howard Finkle, while she was a senior. They graduated on the 19th of May and were married on the 26th.. Howard had already enlisted in the United States Navy, so after he went overseas in the fall, Aimee returned home to help her folks on the farm. After Howard's return, they lived in and around the

Wibaux and Glendive areas. They celebrated their 67th anniversary and 67th class reunion in 2011. They were blessed with two children, JoAn and Jim, who in turn blessed them with 5 grandchildren, 8 great grandsons, and one great-great grandson, with two more great grandchildren on the way. While Howard worked in the oil field and ranched, Aimee was a homemaker all her married life and was a loving, devoted wife and mother. The story of her family is made up of love and time and memory...all the things that really matter, and at the heart of the story will always be this lovely woman. For 25 years, Aimee and Howard enjoyed spending the winters in the Mesa, Arizona area with their Montana friends and classmates hosting dinners, dancing, playing games and attending church. Summers were spent in Montana visiting with relatives and their many friends. In 2009, due to health concerns, Aimee and Howard decided to live full time in Mesa. After Howard's death on May 28, 2011, Aimee moved to Atria Chandler Villas in Chandler, Arizona. Aimee always had a strong faith and she spent many a happy hour testifying to her new friends about her Christian beliefs. Her favorite quotation was "Faith is acting upon what you believe to receive what you want and need".
