November 28, 1917 - April 29, 2015

Albert R. Stude, age 97, of Medora, North Dakota passed away on Wednesday, April 29, 2015 at St. Alexius in Bismarck, North Dakota. Graveside Services will be at 2:00 P.M. on Sunday, May 3, 2015 at the Medora Cemetery in Medora with Jeri Dobrowski as Speaker. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Albert was born on November 28, 1917 in McLean County, North Dakota. As a young man he left home and moved to Billings County, North Dakota where he worked for Page and Lodema Myers. He worked for them three different times between 1941 and 1952. Al worked for Bill McCarty for a period of time. He also worked at several other ranches in Billings County where he broke horses and worked with cattle. He tended bar at the Log Cabin Bar and the Cave Bar in Medora during the winters.

Al met Joyce Scott in Medora and they were married on November 3, 1951 in Wibaux, Montana. They were married for over 61 years. To this union one daughter, Sheila Marie was born.

In 1955, Al went to work for the Gains Ranch North West of Bismarck, currently called the Cross Ranch State Park, where he tended 620 head of cattle as well as all of the ranch chores. In 1956, he began leasing ranches in McKenzie County, North Dakota by the Long X Bridge and in the Grassy Butte area. In 1965, Al bought the Tetly Ranch twelve miles south of Medora. He also leased several other ranches south of Medora.

In 1996, Al retired from ranching and moved to his current residence south of

Medora where he still raised and sold horses.

Al was a member of McKenzie County Grazing Association and the Medora Grazing Association. He was a member of the American Quarter Horse Association and the Paint Horse Association. Inga Olson honored Al by nominating him to the Fifty Years In The Saddle Club.

Al's hobbies included hunting, auctions, horse sales, horse races and rodeos. He especially enjoyed his bucking horse sales.

Albert loved his family, especially his granddaughter and great-grandson. He was an animal lover, they always came first with him. He knew every cow and which calf was hers. He had a special pet dog named Mazie.

Al was preceded in death by his wife Joyce in 2012.

Al is survived by his daughter, Sheila Marie and her partner Tim Irish; one brother and one sister; granddaughter, Sonya O'Brien of South Dakota; great-grandson, Brett Obritsch of Dickinson; one brother-in-law, Arvid Scott of Williston, North Dakota one sister-in-law, Ariann Scott of St. Lewis Park, Minnesota; and numerous nieces and nephews.
