April 9, 1929 - December 15, 2010

Glendive, Montana: Albertonia "Toni" Campbell, age 81 passed away on Saturday, December 11, 2010 at her home in Glendive. A Vigil Service will be held at 6:30 P.M. on Tuesday, December 14, 2010 at the chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 15, 2010 at Sacred Heart Catholic church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Albertonia was born on April 9, 1929 the daughter of Peter and Laura (Schamber) Rome in Hays, Kansas. Toni was raised and educated in Bogue, Kansas, graduating from Bogue High School in 1947. After high school she attended business school in Hutchinson, Kansas and received her associates degree in bookkeeping. Toni moved back to Bogue, where she started working at a bank and later moved to Wichita, Kansas to work for a drilling company as a bookkeeper. While living in Wichita, Toni enlisted in the United States Army in 1954. She served for three years as a payroll clerk until receiving her honorable discharge in 1957. Toni was united in marriage on October 12, 1957 to Clyde Campbell in Wichita. To this union, 10 children were born. Clyde and Toni moved to Dickinson, North Dakota shortly after their wedding and later to Plentywood, Montana, before moving to Glendive in 1965. Clyde worked in the oil field while Toni stayed very busy raising her family. They have resided in the same house for 45 years. Toni enjoyed

sewing, and staying very active in the catholic church and catholic school. She loved watching her sons play baseball and sitting on the porch watching the wildlife and sunsets. She cherished the time she spent with her grandchildren that lived so far away. She was preceded in death by her parents; one son Rolla Campbell; one daughter Amy Campbell; 14 brothers and sisters.
