



Albin "Al" A. Begger

November 3, 1928 - January 8, 2022

Albin Begger, age 93, of Wibaux, MT passed away on Saturday, January 8, 2022 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux surrounded by family. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, January 12, 2022 at St. Peter's Church in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M., Thursday, January 13, 2022 at St. Peter's Catholic Church with Reverend Jose Panickamveli and Deacon Rick Miske officiating. Rite of Committal will be in the Wibaux County Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Albin was born on November 3, 1928 in Beach, ND, the son of Max and Victoria (Kierzek) Begger. He was raised and educated in Wibaux County, Montana and graduated from St. Phillip School with the class of 1946.

Albin entered the United States Air Force in April 1947. In 1948, Albin was stationed in Berlin, Germany during the Allied Occupation of Germany in World War II. He was part of the Occupation Force and served two years and ten months in the Berlin Airlift Division. Albin received the Germany Occupation Medal for his service.

Following his discharge from the United States Air Force, Albin returned to the family farm near St. Phillip. It was at St. Phillip that Albin meet his future wife, Lucille Forster who was teaching at St. Phillip School at the time. Albin married Lucille Forster on October 8, 1951 at the Abbey in Richardton, ND. In the 1950's and 1960's, while farming and ranching, Albin also worked for Sterhan Construction of Glendive, MT. During that time period, Albin was also

involved in the construction of high schools, courthouses, and commercial buildings in Wibaux, Fallon and Dawson Counties. In the 1970's, Albin worked for Agsco selling seed treatment and in the 1980's, Albin owned and operated a Propane Delivery business. In the 1990's and early 2000's, Albin sold several different types of insurance. After his long and varied work career, Albin retired at the age of seventy-eight.

Albin was preceded in death by his wife, Lucille; his parents, Max and Victoria; three brothers; Dominic, Raymond and Frank; one granddaughter, Tyriahna Begger, and one great-grandson, Parker Hase.

Albin is survived by his five children, Alan and his wife Elaine of Beach, ND, Darrell of Billings, MT, Wayne of Springfield, MO, Gerard of Fort Lupton, CO, and Maxine and her husband Todd Finneman of Benson, MN. Albin's extended family includes twelve grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren. Albin is also survived by his sister, Verna Bakken of Billings, MT.
