



## Alf Helvik

September 20, 1917 - March 13, 2006

Alf L. Helvik, age 88, of Wibaux, Montana, died at his home on Wednesday, March 8, 2006. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. Monday, March 13, 2006 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Wibaux, with Rev. Paul Peterson officiating. Interment with military honors will follow services at the Wibaux Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux is entrusted with arrangements. Alf was born September 20, 1917 in Wibaux, the son of Ole and Edith (Anderson) Helvik. He was raised and educated in Wibaux graduating with the class of 1935. In 1938, Alf and his father started a grocery store in Wibaux. Alf worked there for the next 53 years except when he was in the military. He retired in 1991. Alf joined the U.S. Army on March 17, 1942, having served in New Guinea and in the Phillipines. He was honorably discharged on December 24, 1945. Alf married Delaine Jendro on June 2, 1946 in Wibaux. Alf was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church and the Lions Club. He enjoyed playing baseball, bowling and reading. He loved to go to his childrens and grandchildrens sporting events and entertaining them. Alf enjoyed yard work, especially killing dandelions. He was a very mild mannered man who loved his family and community. He will be missed. Alf was preceded in death by two brothers, Harold and Arley Helvik. Alf is survived by his wife, Delaine, of Wibaux; one daughter, Cheryl McCaskey and her husband Ike of Beach, North Dakota; two sons, Larry Helvik and his wife Peggy and Kim Helvik and his wife Sandy, both of Wibaux; nine grandchildren and five great grandchildren.
