August 24, 1914 - January 4, 2015

Alice A. Miller, age 100, of Wibaux, Montana, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Sunday, January 4, 2015 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. A Funeral Service will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Monday, January 12, 2015 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Beach with Pastor Scott Hojnacki officiating. Interment will follow in the Beach Lutheran Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Alice was born on August 24, 1914 in Dickinson, North Dakota to William K. and Emma (Birkholz) Zander. She attended Lefor Elementary in Lefore, North Dakota and then continued on to graduate from Dickinson High School in the class of 1931.

Alice married Emil H. Miller on November 14, 1934, in Wibaux and to this union a son, William E. Miller was born. Emil moved his family to Beach, in 1938, where he managed the Varana Auto Parts for a year, which he purchased in 1939. In 1948, Emil built a new store, Miller Firestone, where Alice was the bookkeeper for the business until they retired in 1967. She then became the bookkeeper for Miller's Grocery after her husband's death in 1969. Alice was happy to call Beach her home for 62 years.

Alice was active in her church; serving on the Alter Guild, Women's Society and the Lutheran Women's Mission League. She helped make quilts that were sent to impoverished countries throughout Mexico and Latin America. Alice was a member of a Bowling League, the Golden Valley Historical Society and

volunteered at the Golden Valley Historical Museum for many years. She enjoyed many activities with priority given to tending her annual garden, taking long walks about town, dancing, playing Whist and Gin Rummy to round out her active life. Her quiet times centered on reading the Bible and many current novels. Alice will be remembered by everyone who knew her for her love of God, family, friends and support of the Beach community.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Emil; parents, William and Emma and siblings, Doris Kubik, Victor (Helen) and Elmer Zander.

She is survived by her son, William (Dorothy) Miller; grandchildren, Pam Dizney and Mark (Liz) Miller: great-grandchildren, Danni and Tim Dizney and Rachel Miller. She is also survived by her former daughter-in-law Ruby (Wyckoff) Miller.
