Allen Chester Gasho, age 82 of Trotters and Beach, North Dakota passed away on Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, March 20, 2024 at Squaw Gap Community Center in Squaw Gap, North Dakota. Interment will take place at South Side Cemetery at Trotters. Allen was born in Beach on November 12, 1941, the first of four children born to Chester and Rose (Turnvald) Gasho. He attended eight years of grade school at the CS Divide school near his home, then to Beach High School, graduating in 1959. Following graduation, Allen attended NDSU for an Agricultural Short Course. He joined the Army and served for two years, part of the time he was stationed in Germany. After he was discharged, he returned to the family home.

Allen married Betty Jean Smolnikar in 1976. They had two children, Dale and Andrea.

Allen spent his life farming and ranching until he semi-retired in 2019. He loved working with cattle and using the horse to move them from pasture to pasture. Allen enjoyed helping the neighbors at branding and shipping time. He participated in team roping with the neighbors and even won a buckle. Allen served on the FSA Board, the Golden Valley County Fair Board, and the

Elevator Board. He also served in various positions for Grace Lutheran Church at Skaar.

Allen was preceded in death by his parents, Chester and Rose Gasho; his parents-in-law, Matt and Edith Smolnikar; his brother, Jerry; sisters-in-law, Colleen, Sandra, and Sheryl; his brother-in-law, Wilfred (Elaine) Smolnikar.

Allen is survived by his wife, Betty Jean; his son, Dale (Hope) and his daughter, Andrea (Brian) Weiss; his grandchildren, Keiffer, Mikayla, Preston, Dylan, and Connor; his sister, Muriel (Don) Sokoloski; his brother, Harlan; his sister-in-law, Linda Gasho; his brother-in-law, Harold Smolnikar; three nephews and numerous cousins.

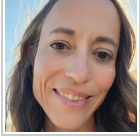
