Allie Nunberg, age 82, passed away peacefully on Friday, October 25, 2013 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive, Montana. Following high school he moved to Fargo, North Dakota where he attended one year of business school until he was drafted into the United States Army serving two years. After his honorable discharge from military service he returned home where he worked on the family farm south of Wibaux. During this time, Allie met and later married his best friend Marijean Sommerfeld on July 13, 1957 at the St. Philips' Catholic Church in St. Philips, Montana. As a couple they moved to Seattle, Washington for a short time where he worked for Boeing before moving to Glendive to work for Daniels Oil Field. They later moved to Miles City, Montana where he worked construction.

Five years later they returned to Glendive to raise their children and have resided there since. As a talented carpenter he worked for many contractors including construction on the Glendive Medical Center. He served as the Business Agent for the local Carpenters Union for ten years. He continued his career as an independent contractor until his retirement. He loved gardening and wood-working; building beautiful pieces of furniture. Family was very dear to him and was always his first priority. He was very proud of them all and was always concerned about their well being even up to the time of his passing. He will be dearly missed by all that knew him.
