



## Alvin Middlestaed Sr.

March 5, 1932 - June 19, 2009

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Alvin Edwin Mittelstaed Sr. age 77, of Glendive passed away on Friday, June 19, 2009 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. After their marriage Alvin served two tours of duty in the Korean War and was again stationed in Korea during the Vietnam Conflict. In 1968, Alvin retired from the Army, receiving his honorable discharge at Fort Sill, Oklahoma. After his retirement the couple moved back to Glendive where Alvin worked for Schwartz Construction, the Coca-Cola Bottling company and then for Western Oil Well Service for 19 years until his retirement in 1994. Alvin enjoyed gardening, yard work, poker, cooking and mechanic work. He loved the outdoors. Alvin took pride in and thoroughly enjoyed the time he spent teaching his seven sons to be young men. He cherished every minute that he spent with his grandchildren and great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters; Olga, Freida and Irene, two

brothers; Ernest and Walter.
