Alvina Brockmeyer, age 91 of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Friday, January 7, 2011 at the Eastern Montana Veteran's Home in Glendive, Montana. Funeral Services will be held Saturday, January 15, 2011 at 10:00A.M. at Saint Paul's Lutheran Church in Beach, North Dakota, with Reverend Scott Hojnacki officiating. A Prayer Service will be held Friday, January 14, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Chapel in Beach. Interment will follow services at the Beach Lutheran Cemetery. Also she was a member of the Lutheran Women's Mission League, (LWML) Circle, and she volunteered at the Golden Valley Manor for bingo and fixing hair. She enjoyed gardening, crafts, canning and freezing produce from her garden. She thoroughly enjoyed sewing and mending. She also enjoyed visiting and having Sunday dinner at the Palace Café in Wibaux.

She loved picking choke cherries with the grandchildren and making jelly with them. Alvina enjoyed having her grandchildren over, she was very proud of them. Alvina was preceded in death by her parents, and three sisters: Edna Witte, Shirley Dorsett, and Mae Weyer.
