Andrew Eugene Clonce, age 34, of Billings, Montana formerly of Glendive, Montana passed away on Friday, May 29, 2020 at his home in Billings. 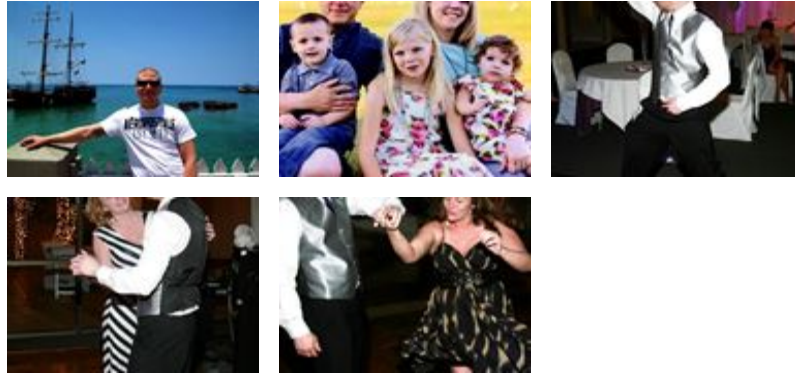
