Ann had a wealth of experience in a thirty-nine year career as an, educator. She taught ten years in rural Dawson County schools at Intake and Deer Creek. She was the principal and a teacher at the high school in Ringling, Montana. She was also the County Superintendent of Dawson County. Ann especially enjoyed her 26 years of service teaching history at the Washington School in Glendive. You could not find anyone who knew this history of the Glendive area much better than Ann. Ann loved her ranch where she spent most of her summer vacations and retirement years caring for her pets and herd of angus cattle. Ann was an outstanding gardener and canner. She was also an accomplished

oil painter and she enjoyed hunting agates. Her father, mother, and sister Emily preceded Ann in death. Ann is survived by cousins who will greatly miss her absence. She will be especially missed by her first cousin Harold Temple and his wife Lou, who kept close watch over her whereabouts the last few years.
