



## Anna Chupp Nadwornick

September 19, 1906 - October 16, 2004

Anna Chupp Nadwornick, age 98, of Wibaux, formerly of Glendive, died on Tuesday, October 12, 2004 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana and was freed from her long struggle with Alzheimer's. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Saturday, October 16, 2004 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Anna was born on September 19, 1906 in Stanton County, Nebraska, the daughter of Carl and Mary (Lueps) Dietz. The family later homesteaded in the Forsyth area where she attended school. Anna was united in marriage to Ammon Chupp on October 11, 1922 in Miles City, Montana. They lived in the Bloomfield community for a number of years until moving to Glendive in 1936 where they raised five children. In 1954, they moved to Darby, Montana where they had a small sheep ranch and later moved to Kalispell, Montana where they lived until her husband's death in 1965. Anna then moved to Glendive to be near her elderly parents. In 1968, she married Jake Nadwornick, who preceded her in death. In 1991, she moved to the Wibaux County Nursing Home. Before the onset of Alzheimer's, Anna enjoyed dancing, crocheting, embroidery, gardening, and her beloved cards, as well as serving as a member of the Women of the Moose and the Senior Citizen's Center. Survivors include one son, Gene Chupp and his wife Geanne of Imnaha, Oregon; four daughters, Francine Guelff and her husband Bob of Glendive,

Ella Mae Pisk and her husband Peter of Kalispell, Melva Mika and her husband Carl of Rainier, Washington, and Audrey Rhine of Roy, Washington; Anna was one of 17 children and is survived by her brother Alvin Dietz and his wife Ida Mae of Dickinson, North Dakota and two sisters, Doris Kenney of Cody, Wyoming and Freda Schulenberg of Billings, Montana; 17 grandchildren and numerous great grandchildren.
