Annette Marie Haggerty, age 73, of Glendive, Montana went to be with the Lord following a brief illness on Sunday, February 28, 2016 at her son's home in Spearfish, South Dakota. A Funeral Service will be at 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 2, 2016 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Francis Schreiber officiating.
