He also worked as an accountant and a crop adjuster. Tony taught school for 24 years and the last fifteen years were in Beach. He retired from teaching in 1976 and worked as an accountant for Cenex before retiring in 1990.

Tony was an avid reader and read thousands of books in his lifetime. He loved

to impart his knowledge and quotes to his children. Tony's yard and garden were a passion of his and he maintained them impeccably. Another of his favorite past times was playing cards with his son Rick.
