January 23, 1916 - February 28, 2003

Antone Richard Nunberg, age 87, of Wibaux, Montana, died on Sunday, February 23, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 A.M., Friday, February 28, 2003, at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux with Rev. Fr. Joseph Ponessa officiating. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 P.M. Thursday, February 27, 2003 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Rite of Committal with military honors will be in the Wibaux Cemetery. Tony was born January 23, 1916 on the family farm near St. Philip's, Montana, the son of Alfred Adolph and Victoria Olga (Mogielicka) Nunberg. He was educated in rural schools in the St. Philip's area. Tony enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps on October 14, 1942 at Fort Douglas, Utah. While in the Army, Tony served in the Pacific Theater of World War II. He received several medals including the American Theater Service Medal, Victory Medal, Asiatic Pacific Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. Tony was discharged on February 5, 1946 at Fort Lewis, Washington. Tony was married to Audrey Parker on July 26, 1943 in Wibaux, Montana. She preceded him in death on September 1, 1971. Tony was married to Laretta Collins Prater on October 31, 1976 in Wibaux. She preceded him in death on February 10, 1996. Tony was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux, Montana and the Wibaux Veterans of Foreign Wars. Tony was preceded in death by one brother, Casmir Nunberg; three sisters, Rose Efta, Hattie Watson and Celia Nunberg; one daughter-in-

law Joyce Nunberg; two stepsons, Robert Prater and Tom Prater. Tony is survived by three sons, Gary Nunberg, Rich Nunberg and his wife Bunny of Wibaux, Montana and Jim Nunberg and his wife Pam of Williston, North Dakota; two stepsons, Tim and John Prater; four brothers, Allie Nunberg and his wife Marijean of Glendive, Montana, Fred Nunberg and his wife Shirley of Wibaux, Montana, Ted Nunberg and his wife Jowayne of Beach, North Dakota and Francis Nunberg and his wife Joann of Minneapolis, Minnesota; one sister, Helen Cox of Beach, North Dakota; twelve grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.
