Ardis Rufsvold Sell, age 75, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, May 20, 2007 at her daughter's home in Glendive. Memorial services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, May 25, 2007 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. She retired from nursing at the Glendive Medical Center on April 28, 1995. She had a gift for bringing life into the world and would ask that you celebrate her life by spending time with those you love.
