December 13, 1919 - March 14, 2011

Glendive, Montana: Ardyce "Ardy" Gertrude Nentwig, age 91, passed away on Wednesday, March 9, 2011 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Unit. Visitation will be held at 8:30 A.M. until 2:00 P.M. on Monday, March 14, 2011 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be at 2:00 P.M. on Monday, March 14, 2011 in the chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Reverend Avis Anderson Officiating. Ardy was born on December 13, 1919 in Glendive, the daughter of Arthur W. and Gertrude (Hilton) Edwards. She was raised and educated in Glendive and had attended Sunrise School in rural Dawson County and Dawson County High School graduating with the class of 1938. Ardy met Merton Nentwig and they were later united in marriage on October 18, 1939 in Glendive. Ardy and her husband bought a farm and ranch which they operated until retiring in 1980 when they moved into Glendive. Ardy enrolled in the Women Of The Moose on July 30, 1960 and on May 7, 1972 she received the Academy Of Friendship Award. Ardy became a College of Regent on June 23, 1974, a Senior Regent from 1971-1972 and was elected Deputy Grand Regent serving from May 1988 thru April 1989. Ardy was very active in the Pleasantview Homemakers club and the Dawson County fairs as an judge and clerk for the produce booths. She had also served as an election judge for Dawson County Elections and as a clerk for the Sunrise School district. Ardy

had been a resident at the Glendive Medical Center since October of 2001. She enjoyed crocheting, playing cards and socializing with friends. Ardy is preceded in death by her parents, her husband Merton in 2004, 1 grandson, Chris Hove and two brothers, Lyle Edwards and Kenneth Edwards. She is survived by her two sons, Don (Diane) Nentwig and Lynton Nentwig all of Glendive, sister-in-law, Helen Young of Burlington, Iowa; five grandchildren, nine great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
