They lived on their farm southeast of Beach, North Dakota, where they raised their two daughters, Laurie (Lance) Bader and Wendi (John) Nusbickel. Ardys and Laurence were married for 56 years, and celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary with many of their family and friends present in August of 2001. Ardys was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Beach where she participated in the Altar Guild. She was

a 4-H Leader for 15 years, belonged to the Home Sentinels Homemakers Club, bowled for 35 years, was a member of the Beach Garden Club, and enjoyed assisting with fixing hair and Bingo at the Golden Valley Manor. She loved being with her family, especially her grandchildren. Ardys was an excellent seamstress who made everything except shoes. She especially enjoyed sewing for her granddaughters and made many lovely figure skating costumes, Christmas and Easter dresses, and doll clothes. She enjoyed gardening and all her flower beds, with irises and sweet peas among her favorites. Ardys was a Jafra Skin Care consultant for over 20 years. Ardys was preceded in death by her parents; her brother, Stanley; and her sister and brother-in-law, Polly and Erv Ueckert.
