Arley Wilson Helvik, age 84, of Billings, Montana, formerley of Wibaux, Montana passed away Friday, November 28, 2003 at St. John's Nursing Home in Billings, Montana. A Vigil service will be held 7:00 P.M. Monday, December 1, 2003 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux, Montana. Mass of Christian Burial will be held 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, December 2, 2003 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux, with Father Denis Fournier officiating. Rite of Committal will be in the Wibaux Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Arley was born November 2, 1919 in Wibaux, Montana, the son of Ole and Edith (Anderson) Helvik. He was raised and educated in Wibaux County Montana graduating from Wibaux County High School with the class of 1937. Following his graduation he began working at the Conoco gas station in Wibaux, and later became the owner of the Helvik Service Station which he owned and operated for 25 years until 1962 when the station was lost to fire. Arley married Elayne Howard in 1938. In 1963 Arley went into the banking business at the First National Bank of Wibaux, handling Insurance. He eventually become the president of First National Bank, a position he held for many years until his retirement in 1984. He and Elayne continued to live in Wibaux until 1991 when they moved to Billings, Montana where they resided until the time of their death. Elayne preceded Arley in death on May 2, 1999. Arley was a member of the Wibaux Lions Club, served on the Wibaux City Council and the Wibaux School Board for many years. He will always be remembered for his humor, his strong work

ethic and his generosity to his family and the Wibaux Community. Arley enjoyed woodworking, remodeling and sports. He is survived by his son Gary and his wife Karen of Billings, Montana; daughter Sandy Haney of Billings, Montana; 5 grandchildren, Nicole Franke and her husband David of Billings, Montana; Jennifer Helvik of Washington D.C.; Eric Haney of San Francisco, California; Nathan Haney of Billings, Montana; Heather Lund and her husband Casey of Spokane, Washington; one great granddaughter Nadia Lund of Spokane, Washington; two step-great-grandsons, Matthew and Bradley Franke of Billings, Montana; several cousins, nieces, and nephews.
