Arloa Vernice (Pfaff) Brane, age 92, was sent to brighten this world on September 18, 1922, and was taken home to be with our Lord on Tuesday, June 16, 2015 at the River Oaks Rehab Center in Fort Worth, Texas. She married Jerome Brane on November 11, 1943. They farmed in the Bloomfield area and later moved to Glendive in 1947 to work and live. They built a home on the Circle Highway and lived there with their four children until

Jerome's death. She moved into town and lived at the Manor and Centennial Apartments.

Her life was an inspiration and delight to all. She always had a smile and never met a stranger. She is remembered as a loving mother and grandmother. She was a caring, compassionate mentor of life to her family and friends. She had a genuine wish for other's health, happiness and success in life. She was truly a member of the greatest generation. As a family we celebrate her life and shower her with love, as she did for us. She was a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic Church and the Altar Society of Glendive, with a strong faith in God.
