



Arnold "Arnie" D. Robson

August 7, 1924 - December 29, 2012

Glendive, Montana: Arnold "Arnie" D. Robson, age 88, passed away with his family by his side on Wednesday, December 19, 2012 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Friday, December 28, 2012 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. A second visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M. on Saturday, December 29, 2012 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, December 29, 2012 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment with military honors will be held in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive.

Silvernale–Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Arnie was born on August 7, 1924 in Dawson County, Montana the son of James Winifred and Veva (Bryan) Robson. He was raised and educated in Lindsay, Montana. Arnie entered into the United States Army on December 1944 and served his country until he was honorably discharged in December of 1946. Following his honorable discharge from military service, Arnie returned to Montana to the Lindsay area where he worked construction with his father. He later purchased a truck which he used to haul grain and cattle for himself and area farmers and ranchers. Arnie met and later married Irene Etzel on October 15, 1955 in Glendive. He and his wife remained residents of the Lindsay area their entire married life. He was preceded in death by his wife in September of 1986. In the early years, Arnie had helped

out at the Lindsay Coop Station. In 1964, he became the rural mail carrier for the Lindsay area residents. He had served as the reporting agent for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for over twenty-five years; delivering weather reports to the Glasgow, Montana weather service. Arnie was instrumental in obtaining a rural fire truck from the Department of Natural Resources to be used by the rural Dawson County firefighters. He received a recognition plaque commemorating his forty years of volunteer firefighter duties in April of 2004. Arnie retired from the rural letter carriers association in 1991. Arnie had served on various boards for Our Savior Lutheran Church. He took great pride in the Lindsay Hall and as self-appointed maintenance man he provided meticulous repairs and upkeep of the Hall for many years. His hobbies included bowling, traveling, playing cards, visiting and dancing; the waltz and Schottische were some of his favorites. He adored his grandchildren and loved attending their sporting events. Arnie's primary enjoyments were time spent with family and friends and his Tuesday lunch dates with family friend, Jeff Doll. He was preceded in death by his parents, James and Veva Robson and two brothers, Ivan and Wayne Robson. Survivors include his daughter, Dallas (Bill) Kennedy of Ekalaka, Montana; sons, Dave Robson of Lindsay and Bryan (Tracy) Robson of Glendive; five grandchildren, Kylee and Seth Kennedy and Kasey, Sadie and Thea Robson and numerous nieces and nephews.
