Arthur H. Gaub, age 73, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, March 21, 2005 at his home in Glendive. Memorial services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, March 24, 2005 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. He had worked as a projectionist for the local theaters, an occupation he held off and on for about twenty years. During high school, Art went to work for the Northern Pacific Railroad and continued his employment with them for eight years following his high school graduation in 1950. Art was united in marriage to Janice Sommer in November of 1949 in Glendive. He then went to work for the local newspaper, the Ranger Review as Shop Foreman, typesetter and job printer. He continued working for the Ranger Review for 23 years and in 1980 returned to his job on the railroad. Art then became the maintenance supervisor at Dawson Community College where he worked until his retirement in 1995. Art enjoyed history and politics. Art was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers and two sisters.
