Augusta Dahlman Geiger, age 79, formerly of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Wednesday, December 4, 2002 at the SCCI Hospital in Mandan, North Dakota. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Sunday, December 8, 2002 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:00 A.M., Monday, December 9, 2002 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Augusta was born on April 17, 1923 in Miles City, Montana, the daughter of Herman and Mary Elizabeth (Hess) Dahlman. She was raised and educated in Terry, Montana and graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1941. Augusta then attended Billings Normal School in Billings for two years. Her first teaching assignment was at the Fetter School and then she taught at the Golden Valley School, both located in rural Dawson County. Augusta was united in marriage to John F. Geiger on April 16, 1943 in Glendive. They resided in Glendive where Augusta worked at the Beanery and the Jordan Hotel Restaurant. Augusta then worked for the Dawson County Assessor's office for 40 years, working first as the Deputy Assessor until being elected as the Dawson County Assessor. Augusta moved to Bismarck, North Dakota in 1995 where she had resided with her daughter until the time of her death. Augusta was preceded in death by her parents; her husband in 1962 and her

brother, John Gardner. Augusta was very active in Zonta, Women of the Moose, V.F.W. Auxiliary, and the American Legion Auxiliary. Augusta enjoyed gardening, yard work and traveling. She especially enjoyed spending time with her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren.
