



Barbara "Bobbi" Helen Stockwell

January 1, 1947 - March 10, 2024

Barbara Helen Stockwell, age 77 of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Sunday, March 10, 2024 with her family by her side. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM until 7:00 PM with a Vigil Service at 7:00 PM on Monday, March 18, 2024 at St. John's Catholic Church in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at St. John's Catholic Church with Father Nicholas Vetter officiating. Rite of Committal will take place at St. John's Catholic Cemetery with Military Honors. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Barbara "Bobbi" was born on January 1, 1947 in Mankato, Minnesota, the first-born daughter of Francis and Dorothy (Shenton) Riederer. She was raised and educated in Pipestone, Minnesota. Bobbi furthered her education at Presentation School of Nursing in Aberdeen, SD graduating in 1967. At her college graduation, Bobbi met Howard, her future husband and best friend. He was stationed in the Air Force at Minot, ND. She enlisted in the army and was stationed in Savannah, GA. Howard and Bobbi married on August 10, 1968 and ten days later, Bobbi received orders and was sent overseas for thirteen months. (Great Honeymoon!) She was stationed in Ascom, Korea, September 29, 1968 at the 121st EVAC Hospital. Following Bobbi's return from Korea, they moved to Denver, CO and started a family. Bobbi worked at Fitzsimmons Army Medical Center in Denver as a Clinical Nurse Specialist in the Neurology ICU for five years. They made their final move to Beach, raising their family in the Catholic church and community they

fell in love with and started a family business. Bobbi became the Director of Nursing at Wibaux Co Nursing Home for fifteen years and finished her career at the Glendive Medical Center. She was an incredible nurse for nearly fifty years and touched many lives in her lifetime.

Bobbi loved to spend time reading, playing cards, board games, camping and fishing. Her most cherished role of all was being a wife, mom, and grandma. She treasured her time with her family and friends, never missed a sporting event, attended many school activities, helped with schoolwork and made scrapbooks. Bobbi loved to create and send beautiful cards to friends and family.

Bobbi is preceded in death by her parents, Francis and Dorothy and her brothers, Gary and Dean Riederer.
