Barbara Elaine Carlson, age 73, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on May 10, 2020 at Sanford Medical Center, Bismarck, North Dakota after a short battle with cancer. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Barbara was born on September 21, 1946 to Harold and Carol (Barendse) Lassell. She was the oldest of three girls. Barbara graduated from Beach High School in 1964. In 1971, she received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Education from Dickinson State University.

On June 7, 1969, Barbara was married to Richard "Rick" Carlson of Beach. Barbara and Rick raised two boys, Reid and Troy.

Barbara ran an arts and crafts store for a short time. She also worked as a substitute teacher in the Beach school system. Barbara was on the initial advisory committee for the Community Learning and Technology Center where she also taught beginning computer classes and she proctored college exams for people doing online classes. Barbara was a member of the Golden Valley Historical Society and the Friends of the Chateau. At the time of her death, Barbara was employed in Medora for many years as an interpreter for the Chateau De Mores Interpretive Center.

Barbara enjoyed macramé, along with other arts and crafts projects, and to research family ancestry. She enjoyed participating in music in school and church. Barbara was also of great support to her father, Harold, after the death of her mother, Carol.

Barbara is survived by her father, Harold of Beach; her sons, Reid and Troy of Bowman, North Dakota and grandchildren, Nicole Carlson and Mathew Carlson; her sisters, DeEtta (Timothy) Frandsen of Mesa, Arizona and Beryl (Gary) Thorson of Watford City, North Dakota and numerous nieces and nephews.

Barbara was preceded in death by her granddaughter, Cianna Carlson and her mother, Carol Lassell.
