Bernice Woodard, age 103, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, November 13, 2005 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, November 19, 2005 at the United Methodist Church in Glendive with Pastor T.C. Chatman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Bernice was born on July 27, 1902 in Platte, South Dakota, the daughter of David F. and Eva (Ensley) Brown. Her family moved to Montana to the Bloomfield area where she was raised and educated. Bernice married Milo Bates on September 23, 1919 in Glendive. They moved west in 1936 and returned to Glendive in 1943. Milo preceded Bernice in death in March 1950. She married Rusty Woodard on January 18, 1955 in Glendive. Rusty preceded Bernice in death on December 13, 1972. Bernice had worked at several businesses in Glendive including the Glendive Golf Course, Glendive Steam Laundry, NP Lunchroom, Woolworth's, City Drug and Gabert Drug until she retired in 1967. Bernice was a member of the Degree of Honor and was secretary of the Rock and Hobby Club. Survivors include her sister, Alice Chesley and her husband Ollie of Vancouver, Washington; and numerous nieces and nephews.
