Beulah June Parpart, age 88, formerly of Fort Peck, Montana, passed away on Monday, January 13, 2020 at the Eastern Montana Veteran's Home in Glendive, Montana. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. on Friday, January 17, 2020 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Private interment services will be held in the Galpin Church Cemetery in Valley County, Montana. While teaching school in Antelope, she met Donald Parpart. Don and Beulah married in Peerless on June 12, 1955. They lived in Shelby, Montana. They were blessed with three children Donna June, Neil Charles, and Ned Alan. In 1963, the family moved to Fort Peck. They lived on the project until the fall of 1970 when they completed the construction of their home in Park Grove. They purchased land in Wheeler. She and Dad raised cattle and horses.

Beulah enjoyed reading mysteries, crafts, and spending time with her children and grandchildren. She and her husband enjoyed doing many activities

together. They would spend a couple winters restoring trunks.

Beulah is preceded in death by her parents, Charles and Elsie Motschenbacher; sisters, Marie Jensen, Lorraine Hansen, Charlotte Jones, and Judith Puckett; and infant brother, Charles.
