



Beverly Jane Lewis

February 9, 1933 - February 24, 2024

On February 24, 2024, Beverly J. Lewis, surrounded by her children, left this worldly home to be with her true love once again. After waiting for five years, she joined Don in heaven.

Born in Breckenridge, MN in 1933, Bev grew up in a small rural town of Kent, MN.

During her days growing up, she spent her time going to school and helping the neighbors with such jobs as cooking and detasseling corn. She also enjoyed going to dances on the weekends.

While Don was attending school at Wahpeton State School of Science, Bev and Don met and their life long journey began. With the passing of Don's father, the decision was made to come back to Lindsay and take over the farm. On April 24th, 1954, they were married and started their life of farming, ranching and raising their four children, Pam, Dean, Barb, and Jeff.

Over the years on the farm, Bev was always there for Don. Bringing ice tea and cookies to the hay fields in July, helping move trucks during the fall seeding, cooking breakfast every morning and supper every night. Over the years her strawberry pie and cinnamon rolls became infamous. Sometimes, during branding, someone would take a pie and hide it, making sure they wouldn't miss out on a piece.

It was common for neighbors to come on a Sunday afternoon to play cards. Literally hundreds of games of pinochle were played in the kitchen and Bev always had coffee and cookies to snack on. More often than not, neighbors

would show up at noon, without any forewarning, and would sit down at the table for a meal. Bev never made just “enough”. There was always food for the unexpected guests.

In 2020, after spending 66 years on the farm, Bev moved to Glendive after the passing of Don. She lived in Glendive up until her death.

Bev was predeceased by her parents, Lee and Sylvia Bates, her sister Vonnie Nelson, her brother Sonny Bates and her husband of 65 years, Don. Bev is survived by her four children, Pam Lewis, Dean Lewis, Barb Neves (John) and Jeff Lewis and two grandchildren, Ashley and Angie.

The family would like to thank the caregivers, Theresa and Donna, that were with Bev over the last four months before her passing. Bev looked forward to seeing and visiting with you every day, more than you will ever know.
