Beverly Ruth Wojahn, 69, passed away November 5, 2004, at her home in Dickinson, North Dakota, following an 8-year courageous battle with cancer. A Memorial service will be held at 7:00 P.M. During their years in Beach, Ed and Bev purchased the Beacon Oil Company, which they owned, and operated for 13 years. Bev was a helpmate to her husband acting as bookkeeper, secretary, and clerk. In Dickinson, Bev worked at various daycare centers, where she was affectionately known as "Gramma Beb" by many children. Bev participated in Al-Anon, Cub Scouts as a leader, Cancer support group, and Pinochle Club. She enjoyed embroidery, collecting Christmas ornaments, and playing board games with her grandkids.
