Billy DeRoy Clonce, age 46 of Glendive, Montana passed away at Glendive Medical Center on Saturday, March 12, 2022 with his family by his side. A Life Tribute Service will be held at 2:00 PM on Thursday, March 17, 2022 at the Silha Funeral Home with Celebrant Heidi Carney officiating. 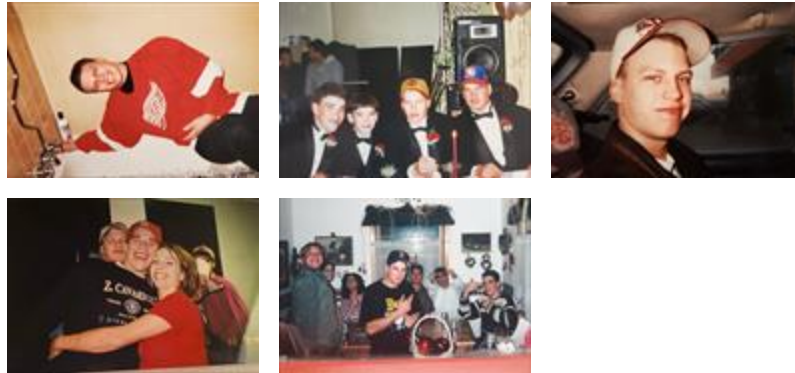
