Blanche V. Bishop, age 89, of Glendive, passed away from this life on Thursday, July 24, 2003 in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, July 29, 2003 at the Assembly of God Church in Glendive with Pastor Allen Bouslaugh and Pastor Don Fercho officiating. In early years, Blanche worked at several restaurants as well as the old Healy Brothers Steam Laundry. She was a wonderful homemaker to her family and known by many for her good recipes but always for her "granny's brownies". Her children will rise up and call her blessed, for not only did she shower them with attention and love but also with her many prayers. Blanche was always busy doing for others - she never complained of her own needs. She has been a shut in due to Parkinson's Disease and has lived with her daughter and son-in-law for eleven years.
