Bob A. Deines, 55, died of brain cancer at St. Peter's Hospital in Helena on August 27, 2005. Graveside services will be held at 1:00 P.M., Saturday, May 27, 2006 in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Bob was born on December 26, 1949 in Glendive, the son of Melvin Eugene and Ernestine (Schock) Deines. Bob worked for BNSF Railway for 26 years. He started out in Glasgow as a brakeman in 1979. He traveled throughout the country as a locomotive engineer and road foreman before becoming a trainmaster. Bob had an adventurous streak. He was an avid sportsman, a big game hunter and fisherman. He was also a boating enthusiast. He was certified to sail and used his license to captain many trips to the Pacific Northwest and Caribbean Sea. He enjoyed scuba diving in the underwater world of Roatan, Honduras; and Tortola, BVI. Bob said, "Life is always interesting. You never know where you are going to go next." Bob had a passion for construction and helped family and friends build and remodel homes. He also loved bowling. He contributed much of his time to Almanor Bowling Center in Chester, California. He helped establish bowling leagues, served as president of the Almanor Men's Bowling Association and was a certified pro shop operator. Bob was preceded in death by his son, Brandon Deines of Glasgow and his father, Melvin Eugene Deines. He is survived by his wife Lynda Deines of Helena; two sons, Fritz Deines of Aurora, Colorado and Guy Deines of Missoula; his mother, Ernestine Deines of Glendive; three

brothers, Gerald Deines of Great Falls, Victor Deines of Glendive and Melvin Deines Jr. of Phoenix, Arizona; three sisters, Linda Martinez of Houston, Texas, Constance Jackson of Sidney, Montana and Colleen Deines of Beaumont, California.
