



Bobby Kuehn

May 27, 1943 - February 26, 2025

Bobby Kuehn, age 81 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Wednesday, February 26, 2025, at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. Graveside services with military honors will be at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, March 5, 2025 at the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive with Pastor Greg Lucido officiating. Following the service, a time of luncheon and fellowship will be held at the Silha Funeral Home Tribute Center. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Bobby was born on May 27, 1943, the son of William and Charlotte (Schopp) Kuehn. On the way to the hospital, a spring blizzard forced his parents to stop, and Bobby was delivered in a shepherd's shack between Sidney and Fairview, MT. He was raised and educated in the Glendive area. He went on to earn an Associate's Degree in Agriculture from Dawson Community College. On his birthday in 1960, he joined the U.S. Army serving his country honorably during the Vietnam Era until his discharge in 1963.

On August 28, 1965, Bobby wed Carol Kittler at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive. To this loving union, three children, Robert, Leigh Ann, and Ty, were born. Bobby worked in a variety of jobs, including with the Soil Conservation Service, the experiences of which led to the establishment of his own business: Kuehn Trenching. His family happily continues his work.

Throughout his life, Bobby was devotedly involved with the West Glendive Fire Department and the Glendive Agricultural Trade Expo (GATE).

In addition to spending time with his flourishing family, Bobby loved to hunt

and fish. He especially enjoyed relaxing and fishing at his daughter and son-in-law's cabin at McKenzie Bay on Lake Sakakawea as well as paddlefishing on the Yellowstone River. He also spearheaded paddlefish cleaning and caviar processing through the Glendive Chamber of Commerce.

Bobby was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Carol, just shy of their 45th anniversary; his sisters, Eugenia Witkowski, Agnes Malkuch, Alice Geiger, Lucille "Sella" Sullivan, and Kathryn Kuehn.

He is survived by his children, Robert (Mechelle) Kuehn, Ramsay, MT, Leigh Ann (Darrel) Kirkland, Watford City, ND, and Ty Kuehn, Glendive; seven grandchildren, Amanda Forney, Mindy Ripley, Mara Canan, Nathan Kuehn, Emily Kuehn, Cody Kirkland, and Rylee Kirkland; nine great-grandchildren, Maia Forney, Bishop Forney, Keaton Ripley, Mable Ripley, Rhyatt Ripley, Barrett Ripley, Aayla Canan, Abel Canan, and Audrey Canan; and his siblings, Glenn (Trena) Kuehn, Glendive, Linda Pearson, Glendive, and Betty Reinhart, Glendive.
