Bradley David Marman, age 56 of Bismarck, North Dakota and formerly of Glendive, Montana passed away on Saturday, February 11, 2023 at his home in Bismarck. Mass of Christian Burial with military honors will be at 2:00 PM on Friday, February 24, 2023 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Francis Schreiber officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Bradley was born on August 8, 1966 in Glendive, Montana to his parents Raymond and MaryAnn (Barthel) Marman. Brad was raised and educated in Glendive. During high school Brad was active on the swim team and the baseball team. He graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1985. After high school graduation he continued his education at the North Dakota State College of Science in Wahpeton, North Dakota where he earned his Drafting Degree. While in college and after, Brad served in the Montana National Guard until he received his honorable discharge. Following his education, Brad returned to Glendive and started working at Williston Basin Pipeline.

Brad married Deborah Ressler in August of 1989 in Glendive, MT and to this union two children were born. Brad received a job promotion that required a relocation to the Williston Basin Pipeline office in Bismarck, ND and continued working there until 2005. At the time of his passing Brad was working at Lowes in Bismarck, ND.

Throughout Brad's life some of his hobbies included water skiing, boating,

fishing at Fort Peck Lake and on the Missouri River. He also enjoyed hunting, snowmobiling, playing cards, and watching his favorite football team the Pittsburgh Steelers. Brad loved spending time with his family, especially his nieces and nephews, who remember him as the fun uncle with a youthful soul and great sense of humor.

He was preceded in death by his father Raymond Marman; one sister, Nancy Bollinger and one nephew, Adam Marman.

He is survived by his son, Leighton (Keremy) Marman and their children, Braeson and Braeleigh Marman, his daughter Brielle Marman all of Mandan, North Dakota; his mother MaryAnn Marman of Glendive, three brothers, Joe Marman of Auburn, California, Roger (Kim) Marman and Gary (Connie) Marman all of Billings, Montana; one sister Sue Ann Marman of Boise, Idaho and numerous nieces and nephews.

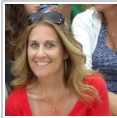
