Brian Patrick Feisthamel, age 53, of Glendive, passed away Sunday, June 8, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. A Vigil service will be held at 7:30 P.M., Wednesday, June 11, 2003 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 A.M., Thursday, June 12, 2003 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Benjamin Lobo officiating.
