



## Bruno J. Rossi

July 15, 1922 - April 21, 2006

Bruno J. Rossi, age 83, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, April 16, 2006 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. A Memory Service for family and friends will be held at 7:00 P.M., Thursday, April 20, 2006 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, April 21, 2006 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Denis Fournier officiating. Rite of Committal with Military Honors will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Bruno was born on July 15, 1922 in Scranton, Pennsylvania, the son of Felix and Amelia (Mori) Rossi. He was raised and educated in Scranton and graduated from Scranton Technical High School. At the age of 17, Bruno traveled by railroad car to Babb, Montana where he entered the Civilian Conservation Corp and worked in Glacier National Park for two years. He entered the U.S. Army in February of 1943 and served in the Pacific Theatre during World War II. During his military service, Bruno became one of the youngest Master Sergeants in the Army at the age of 19. Following his discharge in April of 1946 he returned to Scranton where he was united in marriage to Delta Constantini on April 7, 1947. Bruno worked for Garwood Industries and Chrysler Corporation in Scranton until he retired. He moved with his son to the Great Falls, Montana area and in 1988 he moved to Glendive where he resided until the time of his death. Bruno was a member of the V.F.W. Post #1125 in Glendive. His hobbies included hunting, fishing and

he was an avid baseball fan. He also enjoyed playing pinochle. He was preceded in death by his wife, Delta; his sister, Jean Maldanoto; two brothers, Italo Rossi and Ernest Rossi He is survived by three sons, David Rossi of Glendive, Philip Rossi of Jessup, Pennsylvania and Robert Rossi of Baton Rouge, Louisiana; eight grandchildren, Dawn Torres, Adele, Cody and Wyatt Rossi, Nicole and Melissa Rossi, Kathleen and Andrew Rossi and three great grandchildren, Taya, Vincent, and Meadow Torres.
