Calvin James Bogar, age 80 of Bloomfield, Montana passed away on Tuesday, February 15, 2022 at St. Vincent's Hospital in Billings, Montana. Visitation will be from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Thursday, February 24, 2022 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be at 10:00 AM on Friday, February 25, 2022 at the Glendive Evangelical Church in Glendive with Pastor David Steinbron officiating. He attended college in Bozeman for one year before going to barber school in Yakima, WA, where he became a master barber. After barbering in Sidney, Wolf Point, and Shelby, the newlyweds managed the Derrick Motel in Glendive for one summer before he realized his dream of being a farmer and bought the Ming farm in Bloomfield MT in 1967. During this time, he also served for the Army National Guard from 1965-1971.

Cal and Joanne were blessed with four children: Doug, Beverly, Susan and Kristi. He loved farming and the Bloomfield Community and getting to know

his neighbors. He had a barber chair in his office and enjoyed cutting hair and visiting. The Bloomfield Alliance Church was a big part of his life and he really valued the friends he made there and at the Evangelical Church in Glendive. He was active in the community and served on the Richey school board, the Child Evangelism board, sold AgCo chemicals and was chairman of the FSA board in Glendive for many years. He was always willing to lend a helping hand.

Cal's family and friends were the focal point of his life. He had a gift for entertaining and providing a good time for everyone around, the more the merrier, fasten your seatbelt! He enjoyed his grandchildren, the magnificent 7, and attending their many activities as well as special relationships with his nieces and nephews.
