Carl Oscar Granat, age 90, of Golva, ND, passed away with his family by his side at St. Benedictine Living Community in Dickinson, ND on Saturday, May 16, 2026. Carl was born on September 1, 1935, in Beach, North Dakota to Oscar and Edith Enstrom Granat. Carl graduated from Golva High School in 1953. Following high school he worked in the Beach area. Carl met Donna at a picnic in June 1968 and were married shortly thereafter on November 23, 1968, at the First Lutheran Church in Beach, ND. Following their wedding, they made their home at the Granat Family homestead for a while before moving to Beach. After living in Beach for a time, they moved to Stu Gustafson's farm south of Golva where they made their home until retirement. Carl worked as a truck driver and mechanic at West Plains Implement in Beach and at Golva Repair before starting farming full time. Carl expanded the farm by adding dairy cows. When they retired from the farm in November of 2002, they moved into Golva. They made their home in Golva until August of 2025 when they moved to the Golden Valley Manor in Beach. At the time of his passing, he was a resident at Benedictine Health Center in Dickinson.

During their time on the farms, their 3 children were born, Laurie in October of 1969, Julie in August of 1971 and Scott in April of 1976. He was a caring, patient and loving father. He was easy going and up for anything whether it was playing cards, board games or watching old TV shows. He had the ability to fix anything, build anything and shared his knowledge with his neighbors. Carl's retirement jobs included working for the City of Golva checking water meters and maintaining city property and being a farm hand for Andy Vanvig. He enjoyed shaking dice at the Golva Station and catching up on the latest news. Carl was a member of First Lutheran Church, Golva Co-op Elevator Board and Lutheran Cemetery Board.

Carl is survived by his daughters, Laurie Goodrich and Julie (Randy) Binstock of Dickinson; his son Scott (Samantha) of Gillette, WY; Grandchildren Jade Watson, Dickinson; Jackson (Abigail) Binstock, Bismarck; Tanner (Aubrey) Binstock, Dickinson; Sydney Binstock, Bismarck; Allison Granat and Eric Granat, Gillette and 6 great-grandchildren and one on the way.
