While living in Glendive, Caroline worked at Eastmont for sixteen years until her retirement at age 85. Caroline was a laid back kind of person that always felt everything will work out, she didn't

understand what people meant by stress. Caroline enjoyed working in the garden and liked to crochet. Caroline had a strong sense of adventure and traveled on many senior tours, including New England, Florida and California. She even ventured to Europe with her granddaughter Cyndee, bringing home many memories. Caroline deeply loved her family and was especially proud of the fact that two of her great granddaughters were named after her. Caroline was preceded in death by her parents, Henry and Lydia Heimbuch; all of her siblings; husband, Fred Schell in 1968; one step grandson, Tim Krieger as well as her best friend, Lydia Lachenmaier.
