April 9, 1910 - March 27, 2007

Caroline (Kaul) Vegele, went to her heavenly home peacefully in her sleep on Saturday, March 24, 2007. She was 96. A Prayer Service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Monday, March 26, 2007 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Her father married Katherine Gaub in 1920. After her father passed away in 1932, Caroline went to South Dakota to live with her older brother and sister-in-law, John and Katie Kaul. Caroline worked in the Eureka, South Dakota area for area farmers and at the Aberdeen Hospital. On April 12, 1936, she married Emil Vegele in Hosmer, South Dakota. Following their marriage, they moved back to the Marsh, Montana area. In 1942, they moved to Glendive where they resided since. They were married for 60 years when Emil passed away in 1996. Caroline enjoyed quilting, sewing, gardening, cooking and her wringer washing machine! Her greatest joy in life were her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. Caroline was preceded in death by her husband Emil; two brothers, John and Fred Kaul; three sisters,

Lydia, Martha and Pauline; three step brothers, Edwin, August and David Gaub; three step sisters, Marie (Mrs. Jacob Siegle), Lydia (Mrs. Gideon Ulrich) and Hilda (Mrs. Henry Oliver); her half sister, Martha.
