Cecelia Rose (Schwindt) Hafele, aged 72, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away Saturday, January 23, 2016 at Sanford Health in Bismarck, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 3:00 P.M. on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 at the Silha Funeral Home in Beach and from 9:00 A.M. until 10:00 A.M. at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial, (Celebration of Life) will be celebrated on her birthday at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, January 28, 2016 at St. John's. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 at St. John's Catholic Church with Father Dan Berg officiating. Rite of Committal will follow services. She was a daughter and an only child to Jacob and Pauline (Boehm) Schwindt. Cecelia received her early education in Killdeer and when she was twelve her mother passed away and she stayed in Dickinson with family while attending school. She later attended St. Mary's boarding school in New England, North Dakota where she graduated with the class of 1961.

Cecelia met and later was united in marriage to Louis Hafele on May 11, 1962 in Killdeer. They began married life in Grassy Butte, North Dakota where two of her children, Debbie and Pam were born. They then moved to the Hafele Ranch thirty miles north of Rhame, North Dakota and it was here that Danny, Beth Ann and Susan were born. Cecelia and Louis raised their five children at

this family homestead. The couple retired and moved to Beach on October 29, 2010 and she lived here until the time of her passing.

Cecelia took great pride in her husband's accomplishments in his trapping and fur business as well as ranching. She was proud of being a homemaker and loved raising her family. Cecelia was a major helpmate to her husband and was always willing to help with cattle, haying, trapping or whatever they were doing at the time.

She thoroughly enjoyed her grandchildren's sports and extra-curricular activities. She is still a Beach Bucs fan! She also served as treasurer for the North Dakota Fur Takers Organization. After moving to Beach some of her favorite times was getting together with her cousins in Glendive, Montana. Cecelia enjoyed serving with the ladies group at the Catholic Church at various functions. Church was a big part of her life and she had a strong faith with the Lord.

Cecelia was preceded in death by her parents and one son, Daniel Hafele. 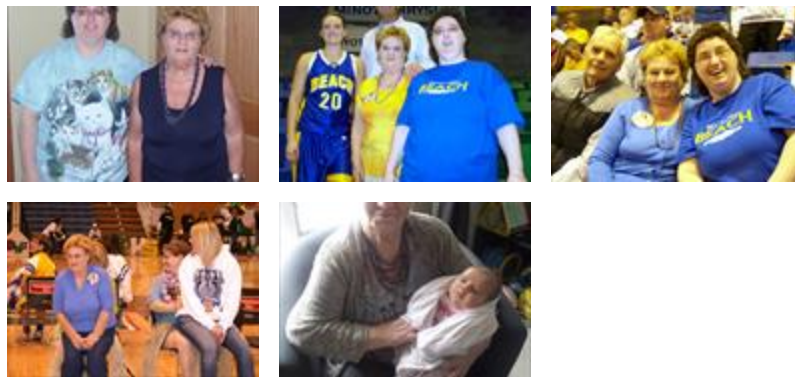
