Charlene Grace Haugen, age 77, passed away on Saturday, June 13, 2015 at her home in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 12:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 18, 2015 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Stan Hoobing officiating. Charlene was born on September 13, 1937 in Fargo, North Dakota a daughter of Charles and Arlene (Thomason) Babcock. She was raised and educated in Lisbon, North Dakota graduating from Lisbon High School with the class of 1955. Following high school, Charlene continued her education at the University of North Dakota in Bottineau, where she received her Nursing Degree.

Charlene met and later married Harvey Haugen on October 6, 1962 in Lisbon, and to this union three daughters were born; Randi, Keek and Holly. Shortly after their marriage they had moved to Glendive, where Charlene worked as the County Health Nurse for several years. In 1985 they moved to Akron, Colorado and bought a restaurant that they operated side by side for eight years. After the restaurant closed they moved to Burlington, Colorado and later back to Akron when Harvey passed away in 2000. In 2003, Charlene

moved back to Glendive where she has resided ever since.

Charlene was a wonderful nurse who helped pioneer Home Health for the State of Montana and the rural counties of Colorado. She was a woman ahead of her time. Charlene always put other ahead of herself and was known for her big heart. She loved her family and cherished the time spent with her grandchildren. After Charlene moved back to Glendive she spent a lot of time helping at the Zion Lutheran Furniture Room, worked at the Food Bank and was one of the Auxiliary Pink Ladies.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband Harvey.

Survivors include her three daughters, Randene (Max) Peiper of Brighton, Colorado, Kaari (Ross) Fulton of Glendive and Holly Haugen-Emerson of Glendive; five grandsons, Lance (Shalena) Haugen, Brian Fulton, Matthew Fulton, Coy Emerson and Dalton Emerson; one great grandson, Brody Haugen; one brother, Ken (Carolyn) Babcock of Fairview, Montana; nieces, Lynn and Dell Shelmerdine and family of Fairview, Montana and Lori and Greg Adkins and family of Kalispell, Montana; one nephew, Steven and Kimberly Babcock and family of Billings, Montana; godchildren, Danny Haugen and Ashley Langton and numerous nieces and nephews.
