April 17, 1917 - January 15, 2009

Charlotte L. Cox, age 91, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Friday, January 9, 2009, at the Fallon Medical Complex in Baker, Montana. Funeral Services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, January 15, 2009, at the United Community Church in Beach with Reverend Warren Maxted officiating. Interment will follow in the Beach City Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Charlotte was born April 17, 1917, the daughter of Dart A. and Bernice (Cheesman) Cox. In 1909, before Charlotte's birth, her family purchased a farm near Carlyle, Montana. In 1916, they moved south of Beach where Charlotte was born a year later. Charlotte was received her early education at the Cox School and graduated from Beach High School with the class of 1935. Charlotte was confirmed in the United Methodist Church of Beach and continued life-long attendance and involvement. She served as president of the Women's Group and church school teacher. She was also on the church board and a faithful member of the church choir. After Beach Methodist Church merged with the United Church of Christ, Charlotte continued her steadfast relationship in the United Community Church where she also sang in the choir, served on the church board and worked in the Women's Fellowship. Charlotte served on the Beach City Cemetery board for many years and was employed at the Dickinson's Department Store until her retirement. Charlotte enjoyed embroidery, reading, bird watching and gardening. She loved to go arrowhead hunting with her friend, Rita Melvin. Charlotte was preceded in death by her parents; sister,

Virginia; brother, Charles and his wife Helen; and one niece, Paula Wicka. Charlotte is survived by her sister, Joyce Vernon and her husband Don of Montrose, Colorado; four nieces: Rosalyn Elder, Marilyn Cox, Charlene Bostyan and Renee Lee; and four nephews: Dan Cox, Brian Kurtz, Lynn Kurtz and Colin Kurtz.
