Cherie May Oakland, age 54 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Thursday, September 16, 2021 at the Billings Clinic in Billings, Montana. Visitation will be from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Sunday, September 26, 2021 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. A Life Tribute Service will be at 11:00 AM on Monday, September 27, 2021 at Gunner's Ridge in Glendive with Celebrant Heidi Carney officiating.
