Clara Tillman Trocinsky, age 91, of Glendive, passed away on Saturday, July 19, 2003, at Magnolia Place care center in Billings. Her husband Tom, a railroader, was transferred to Mandan, ND in 1947 where they resided until 1949 at which time they were transferred back to Glendive with the Northern Pacific Railroad. Clara was a generous, loving person who was always giving and thinking of other people. She loved being with family and friends, her many nieces and nephews and grandnieces and nephews. gatherings and playing cards were her delight. She loved winning at cribbage. Clara was an avid volunteer, an active member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive, she also enjoyed traveling, music and any occasion for a good time.
